



Can I agree to donate some organs and not others?

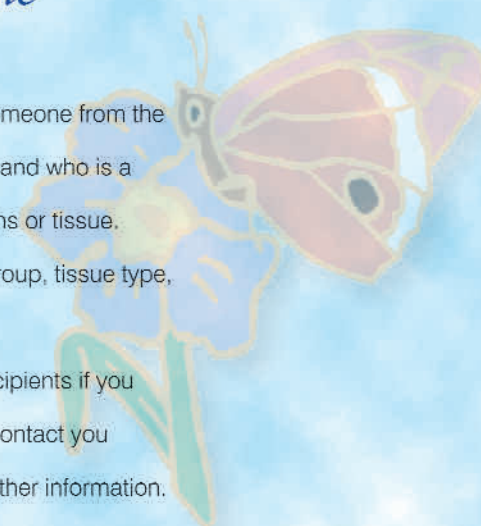
Yes, if that is your wish and you feel it would meet the wishes of your loved one if they had not made a clear decision about their wishes.

Who will receive the organs or tissue?

The organ or tissue recipient will be someone from the transplant list who is in greatest need, and who is a good match for your loved ones' organs or tissue.

A good match will depend on blood group, tissue type, age and other medical factors.

You may receive information on the recipients if you wish. The transplant co-ordinator will contact you following the transplant with this and other information.

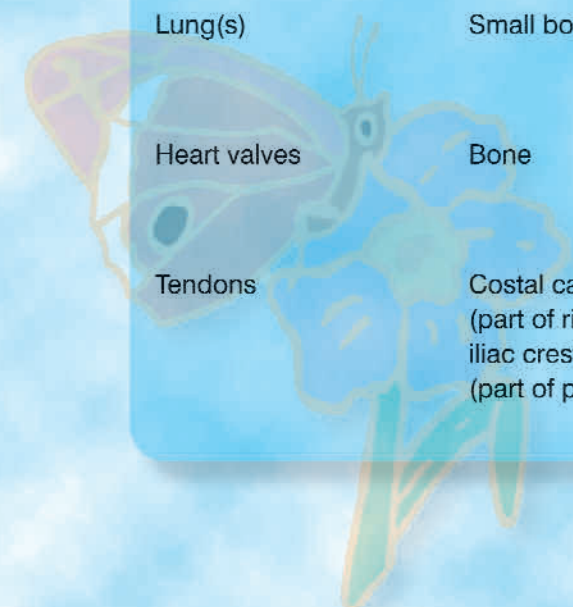


Organ & Tissue Donation

What can be donated?

At present, in the UK, the following organs and tissues can be donated for transplant:

Liver	Kidney	Liver & kidney
Kidney & pancreas	Heart	Heart & lungs
Lung(s)	Small bowel	Skin
Heart valves	Bone	Corneas
Tendons	Costal cartilage (part of ribs) & iliac crest (part of pelvis)	Meniscus (part of knee joint)
